The election was called to order by President Terry Clark followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

A quorum was confirmed by the Secretary.

President Clark welcomed everyone to the meeting and called on Bob Stanionis who led the search for candidates for President and Vice President to address the MAC.

Bob Stanionis advised the MAC that he had one candidate for President, Terry Clark, and one candidate for Vice President, Bob Maron, for 2024-2025. Terry and Bob had indicated they would be willing to serve a second term. Bob Stanionis then asked if there were any other nominations from the floor. No additional nominations were received. Bob made the recommendation to accept the nominations as given and to have the MAC Secretary cast one ballot of acclamation for Terry Clark as President and Bob Maron as Vice President for 2024-2025. Terry Clark made the motion to approve and Bill Jones, Printing Committee, seconded the motion.

Secretary Tresea Frazier cast one vote electing the following:

Terry Clark elected President of BB-MAC for 2024-2025  
Bob Maron elected Vice-President of BB-MAC 2024-2025

EC Member Greg Frazier reminded the MAC that we need new people to step up and take over these leadership roles. Without new leadership, MAC may not continue to exist. He also asked if anyone was interested in being a member at large on the executive council, to please contact Terry. This position is a good way to learn the operations of the MAC.
