<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard lighter background fabric
 1 yard green for leaves and binding
 (Optional - Christmas fabric)
 Double-faced fusible for leaves and stem (1/2 yd)
 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard Fabric for backing

#### Christmas Ribbon Table Runner - Nancy Ekstrom

Approx. 40" x 18" 1/3 yd red 1/3 yd. white  $\frac{1}{2}$  yd green (includes binding) Fabric for backing

# Christmas Santa Gift Bag – Janine Apple

White felt or vinyl -  $6" \times 9"$  for snowman head and body

Black felt or vinyl - 6" × 9" for boots

Buttons – 2 small black (or beads) for eyes AND 3 colorful buttons for belly

12" x 12" two-sided iron on Heat'n'Bond

Gift bags: if you have an extra 8"  $\times$  11" or 10"  $\times$  12" gift bag, please bring them

Three contrasting colors:

- 1. Dark 6" × 9" patterned for coat and hat
- 2. Medium  $3'' \times 3''$  solid for gloves and hat rim
- 3. Light 1" x 9" scrap for scarf and hearts (plaid words well)

# Jelly Roll Strip Quilt

This pattern will make a 39  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50  $\frac{1}{2}$ " quilt

1 bundle of neutral jelly roll strips

1 bundle of assorted color jelly roll strips

 $\frac{1}{2}$  yard neutral background fabric

 $1\frac{1}{2}$  yards backing

43  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54  $\frac{1}{2}$ " batting

(left over jelly roll strips will be used for binding)

Sew four 5" squares together in men's colors and bring in sometime in January to donate. Backstitch on the ends and do not trim. Thanks!

Sew four 5" squares together in children's prints and bring in sometime in February to donate. Backstitch on the ends and do not trim. Thanks!

## Project Bag – Kathy Patterson

Fusible fleece or batting  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Backing fabric -  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Lining (front)  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Accent fabrics:  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ ", and  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " Zipper 12-16" poly Vinyl  $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " \*Note: This pattern will make a  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " project bag. Many quilters prefer a 15" project bag. You'll need a little bit bigger pieces if you do!

## Block of the Week (6 different blocks)

I suggest at least 4 colors, plus a background fabric. Scraps or yardage can be used. Maybe you'll make more blocks for a larger quilt, or maybe you'll make a table runner and some pillows. It's all up to you!

### Pillowcase - Jeannine Hartman

3/8 yard - pillowcase band 7/8 yard - pillowcase body 1 ½" WOF for flange (optional)

## Fabric Frog 15" - Nancy Schulte

2 Fat Quarters and pieced scraps to equal one 18 x 21 in rectangle for frog top 18" x 21" batting 32 oz bag Poly Pellets Buttons for eyes

### Tool Holder – Diane Heimel

3 fat quarters Batting or fusible fleece 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Velcro 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " or closure of your choice

### Casserole Caddy - Nancy Schulte

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard outside fabric
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard lining fabric
Fat Quarter for trim
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard batting
Optional - <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard Thinsulate

### Mystery Quilt - Jeannine Hartman

18  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44" Color 1 - Medium to Dark -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard (includes binding) Color 2 - Medium 5" Width of Fabric or 1 fat quarter Color 3 - Fat Quarter (or enough for 12 - 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares) Background -  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard Backing and batting

1 jelly roll or (40) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips Background - 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards Accent - 1 yard Outer Border - 2 yards Binding - 1 yard Backing - 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  yards
